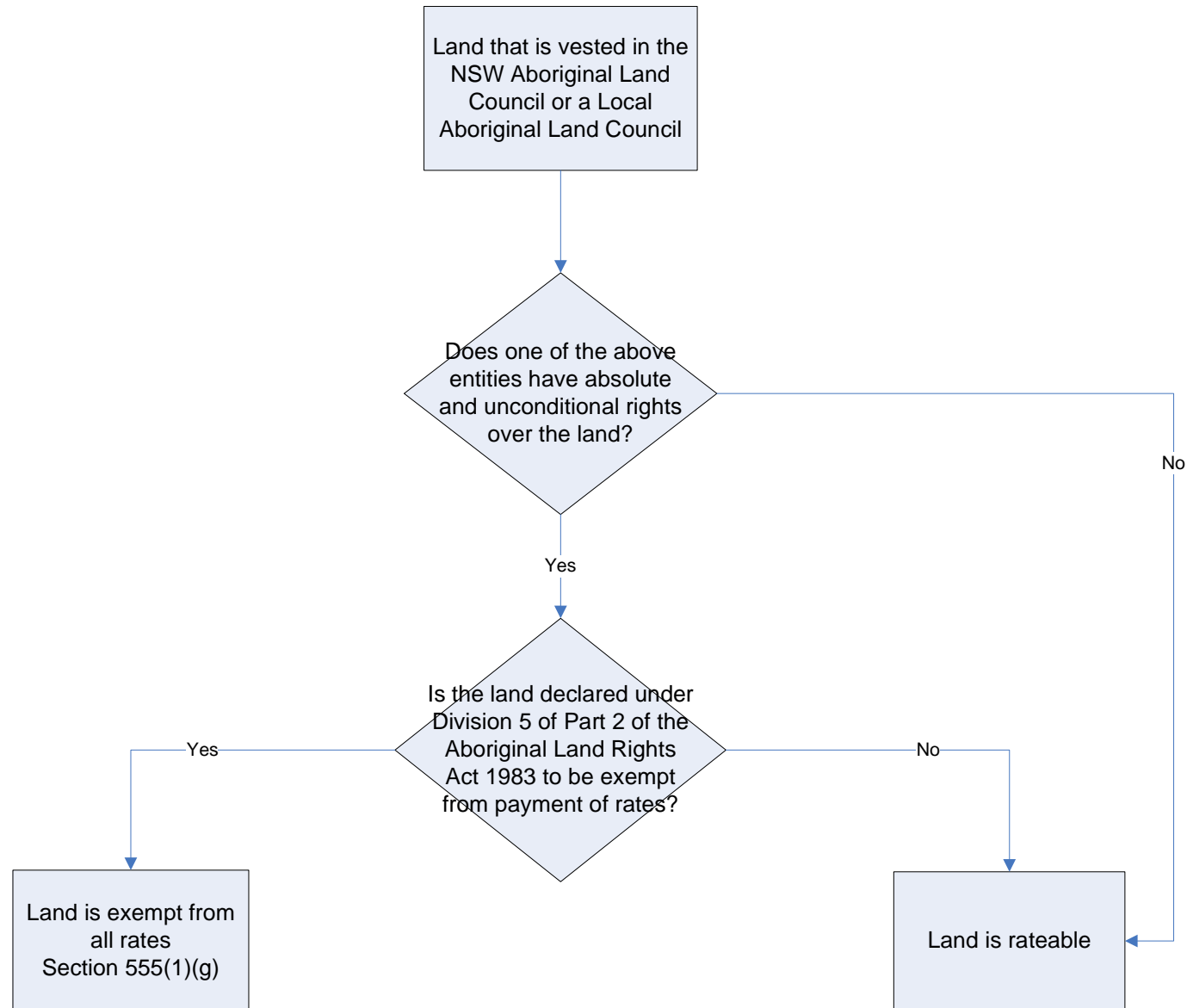


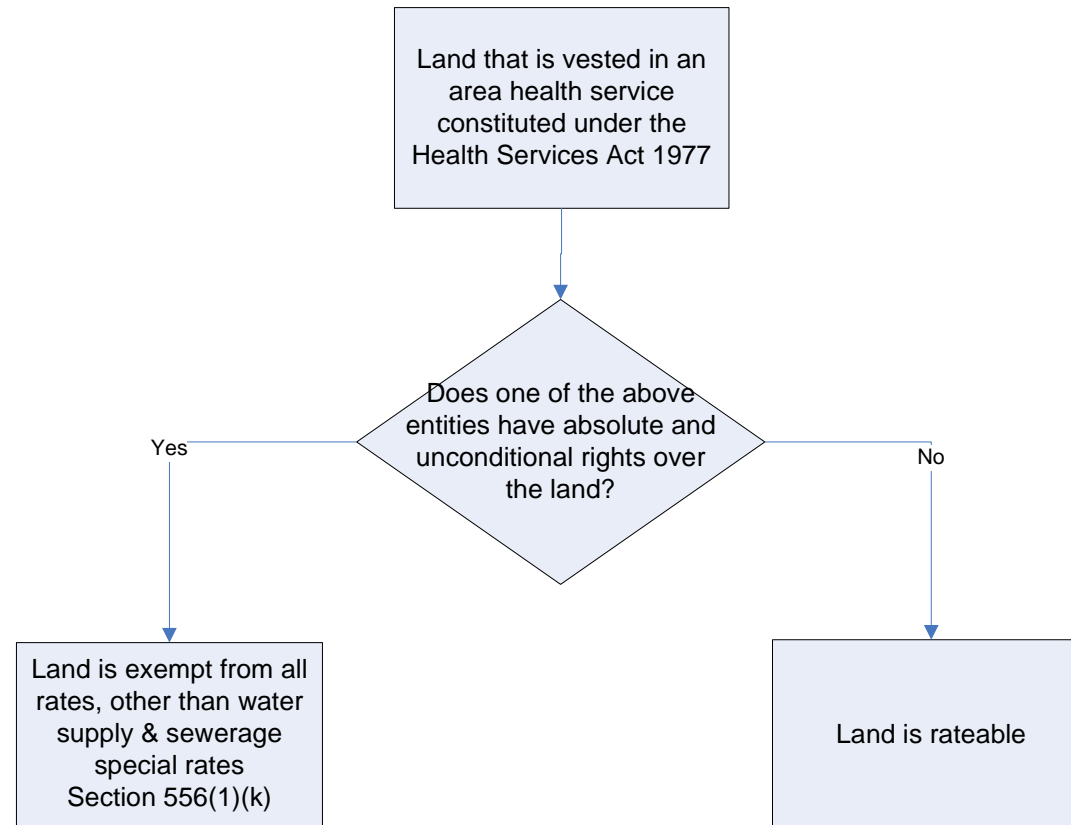
Land that is vested in the NSW Aboriginal Land Council or a Local Aboriginal Land Council

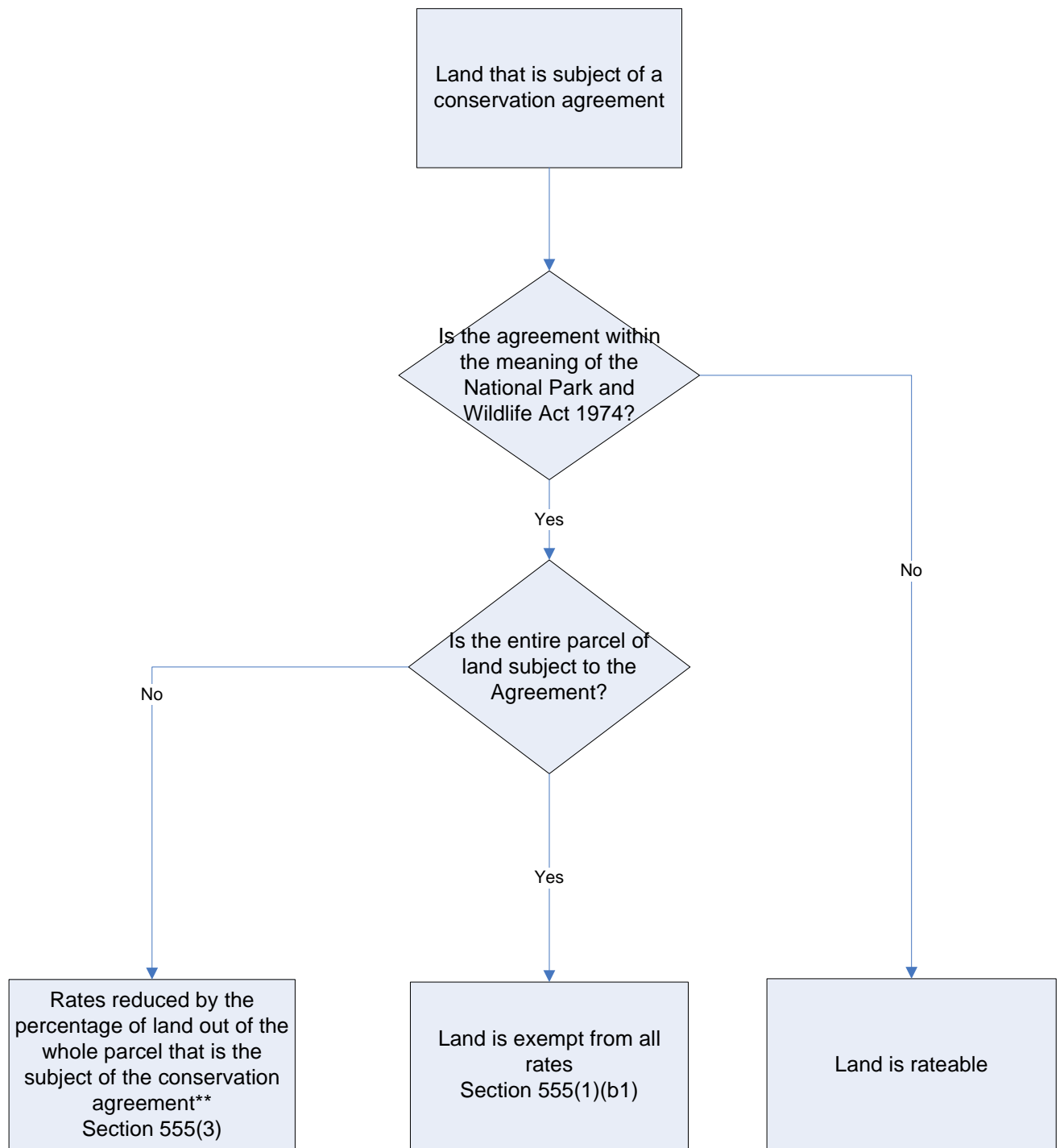
Land that is vested in an area health service constituted under The Health Services Act 1977

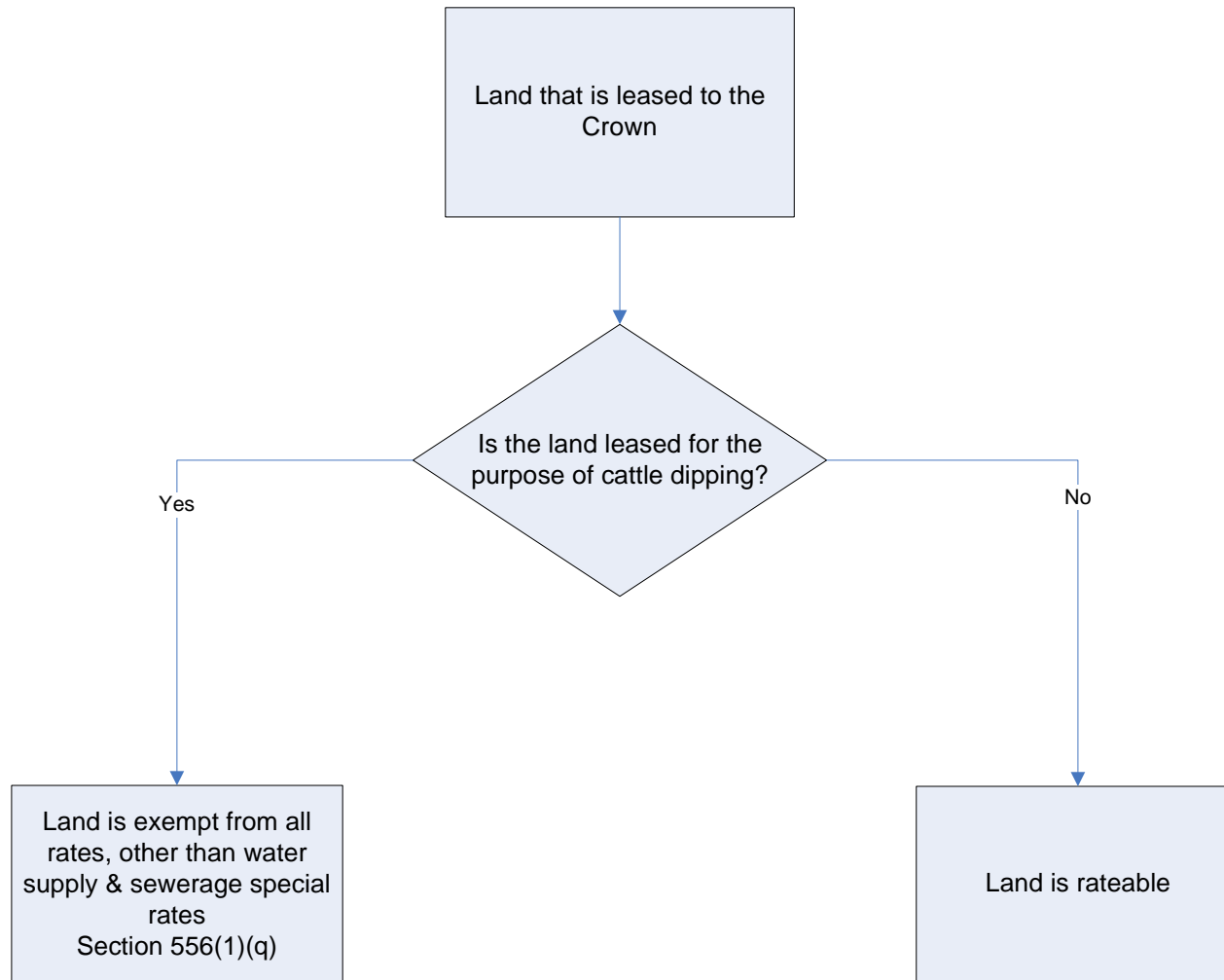
Land that is the subject of a conservation agreement



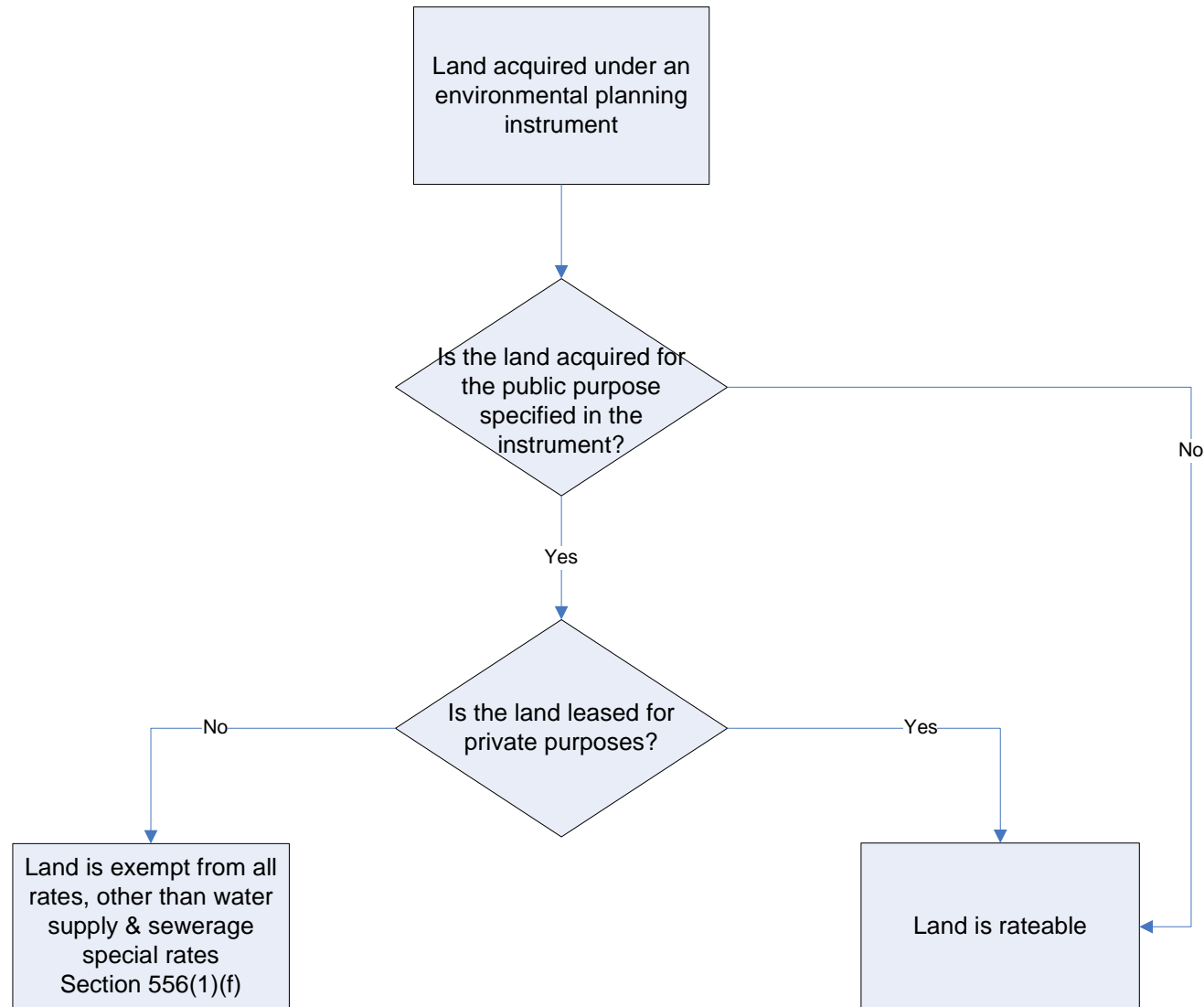
Notes:

** For example, if 40% of the parcel is the subject of the conservation agreement, rates are reduced by 40%.

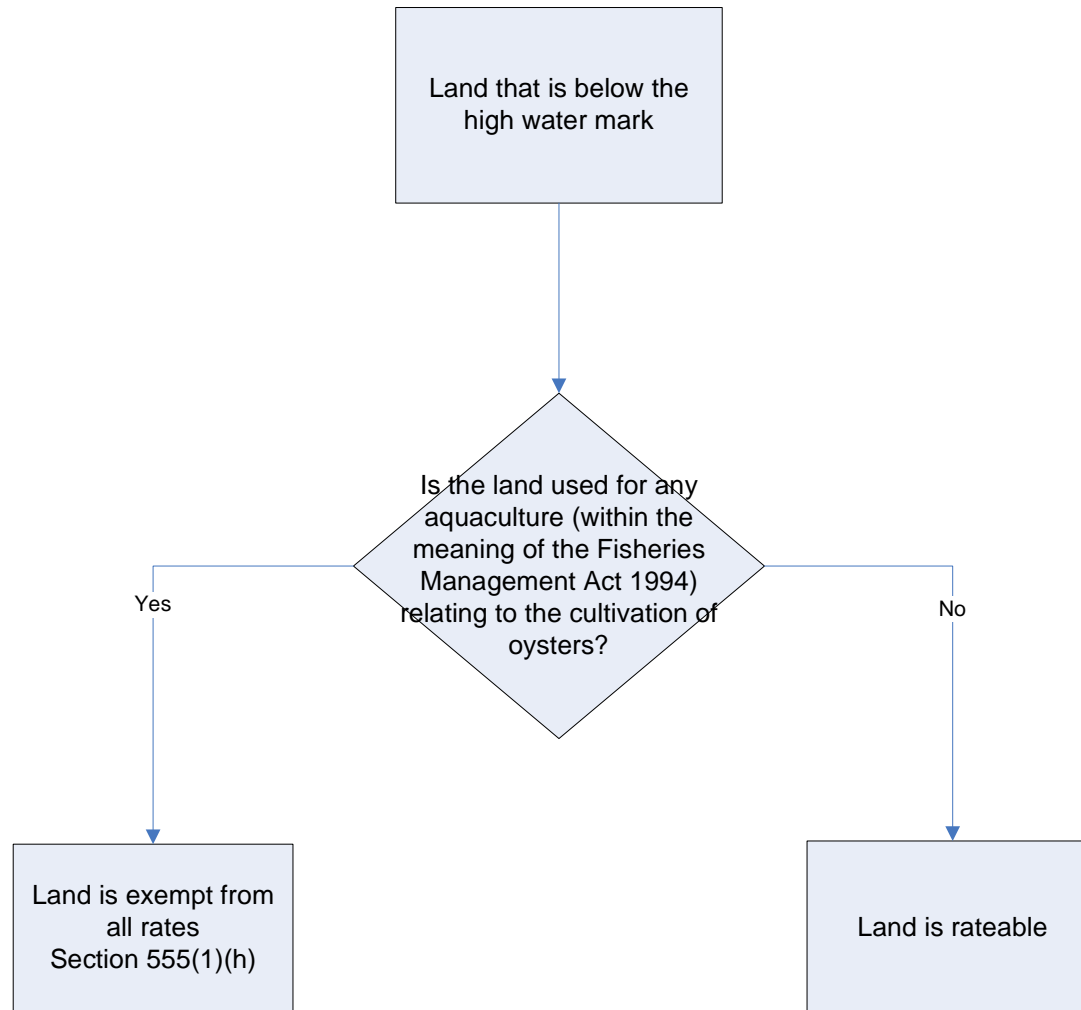
Land that is leased to the Crown



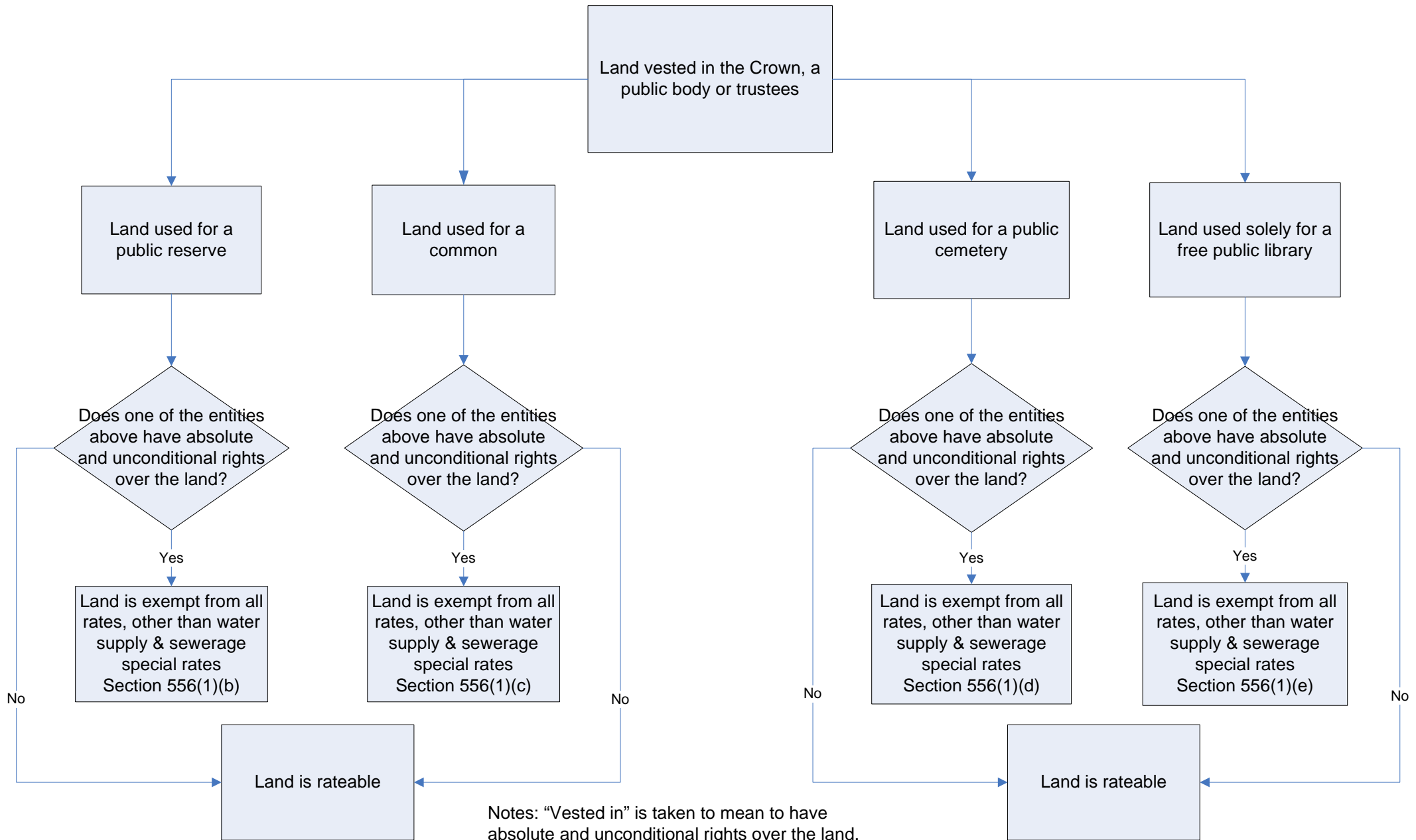
Land acquired under an environmental planning instrument



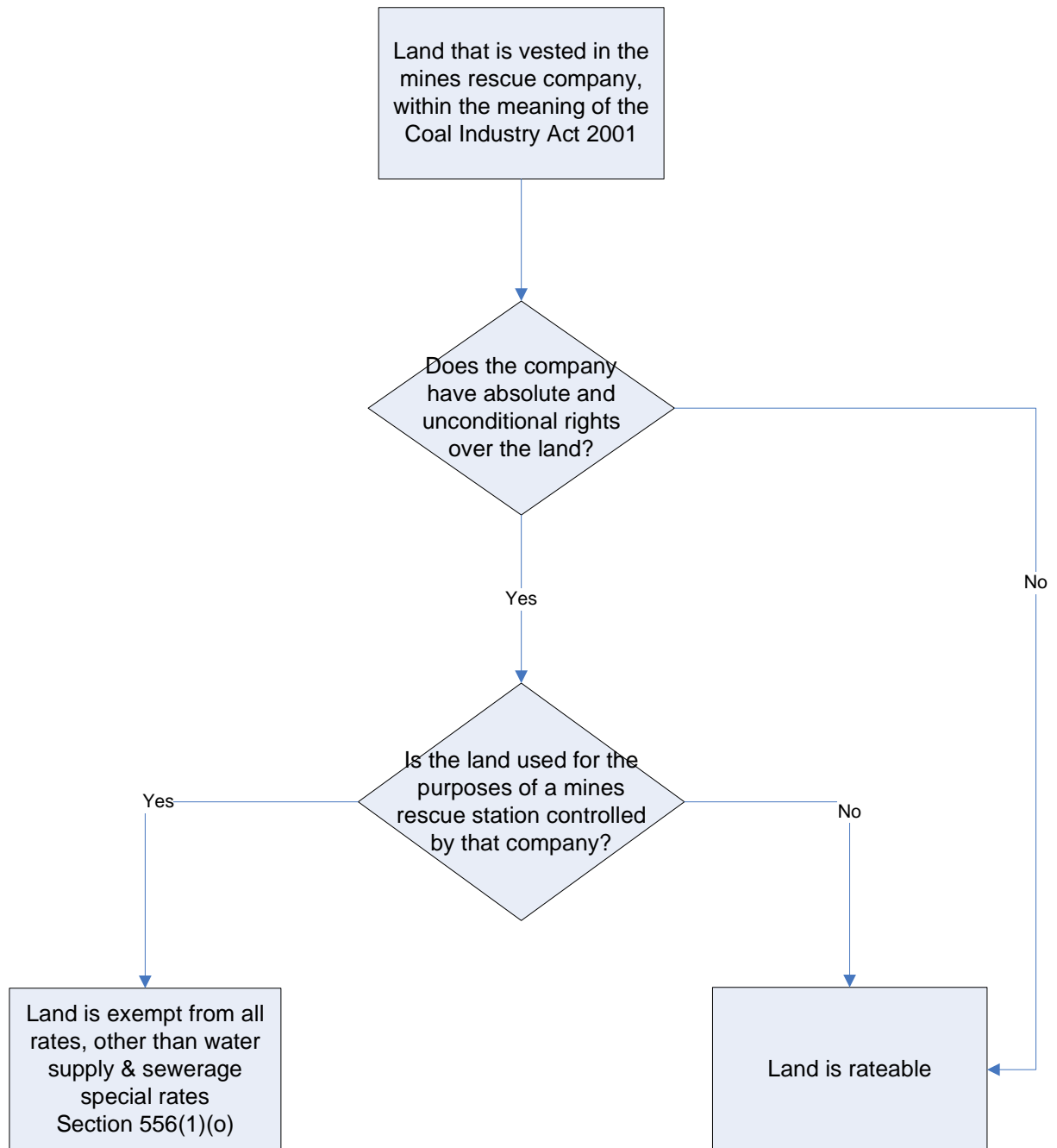
Land that is below the high water mark



Land vested in the Crown, a public body or trustees



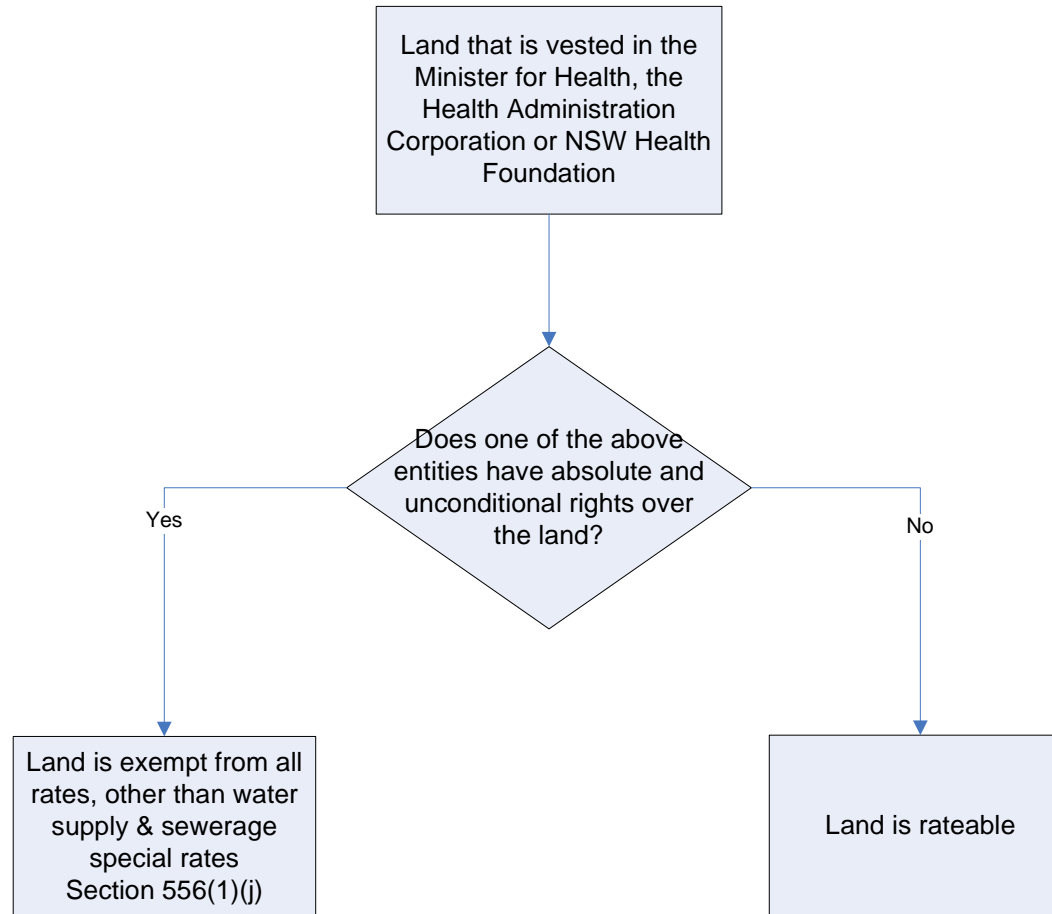
Land that is vested in the mines rescue company

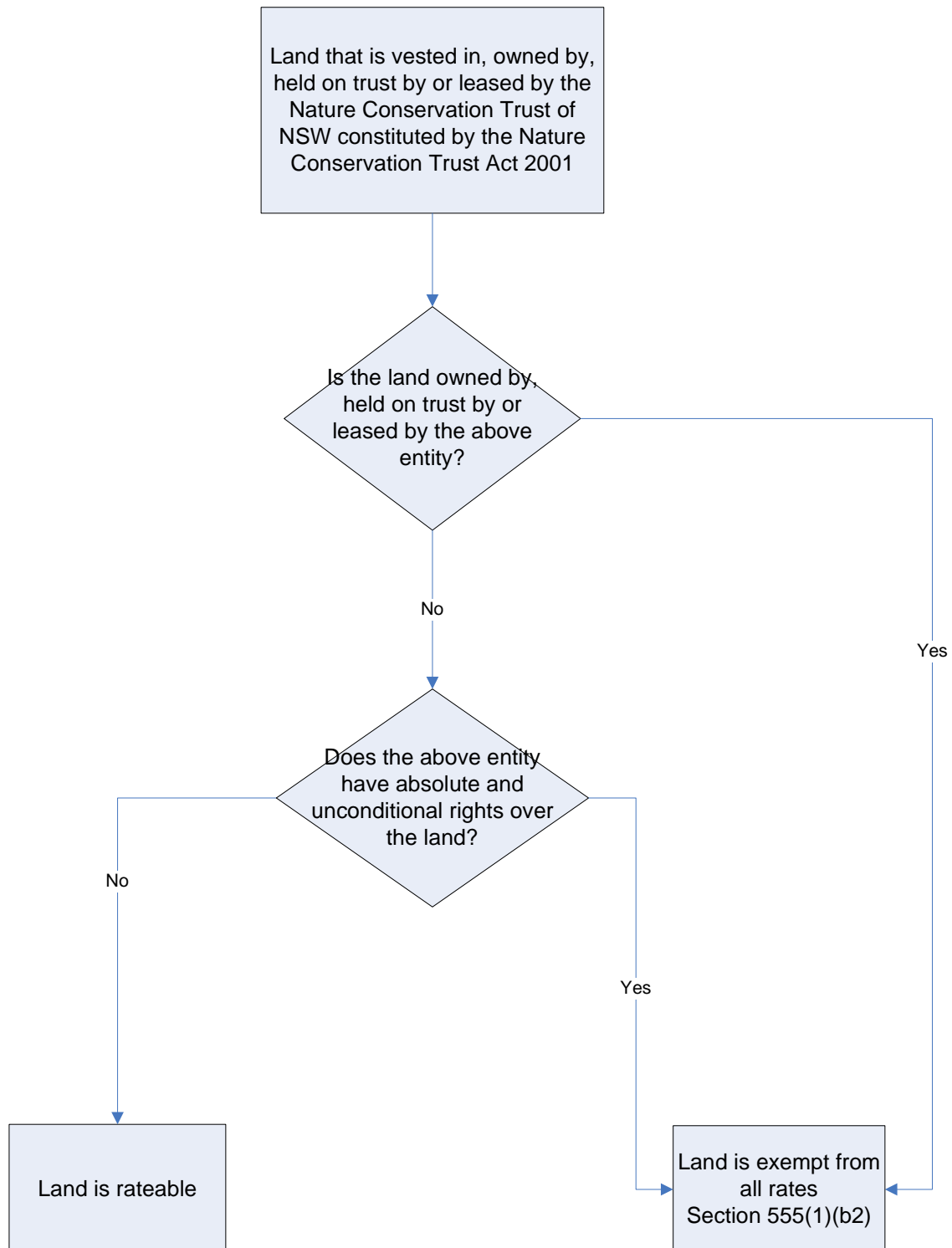
Land that is vested in the Minister for Health, the Health Administration Corporation or the NSW Health Foundation

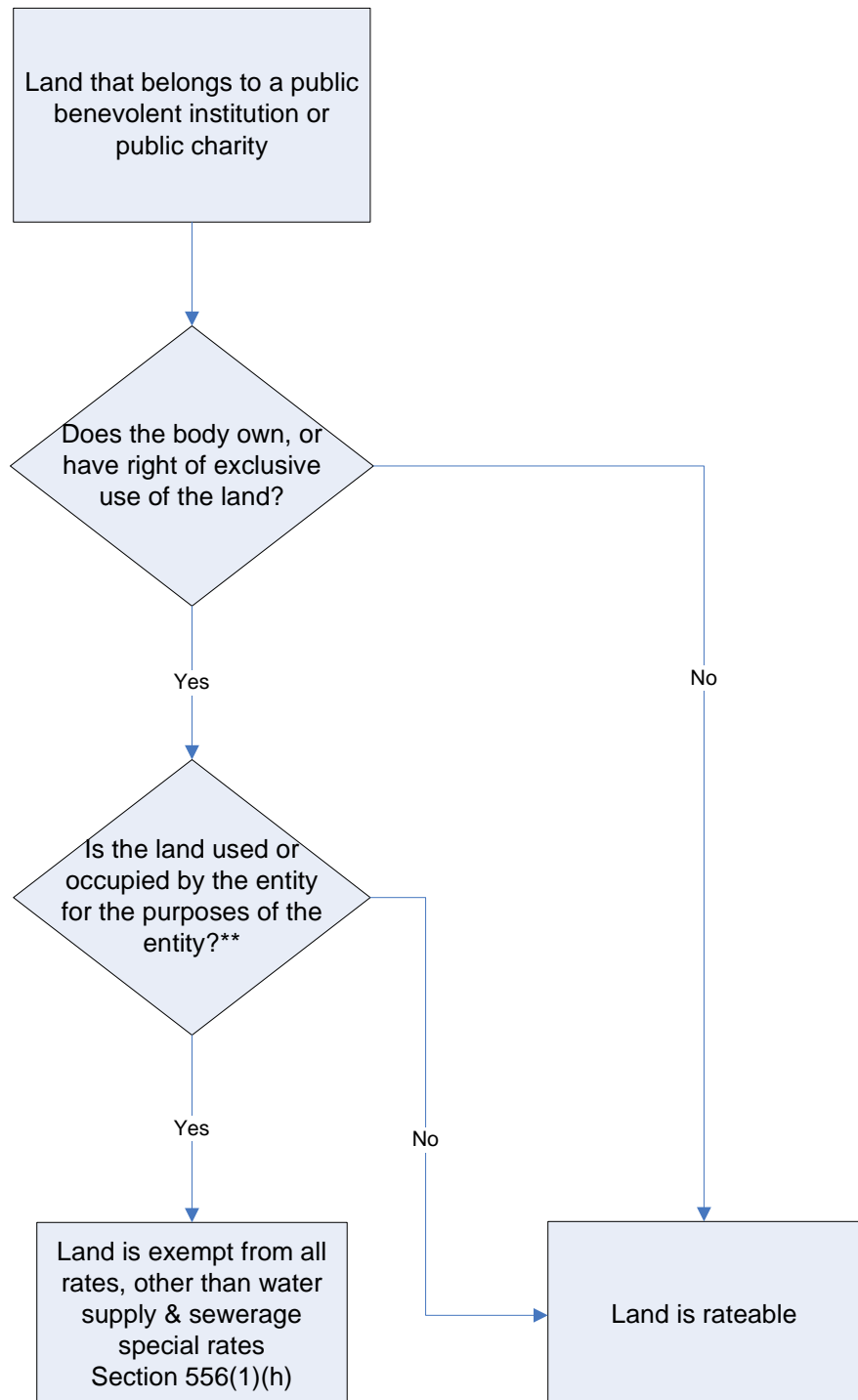
Land that is vested in, owned by, held on trust by or leased by the Nature Conservation Trust of NSW

Land that belongs to a public benevolent institution or public charity

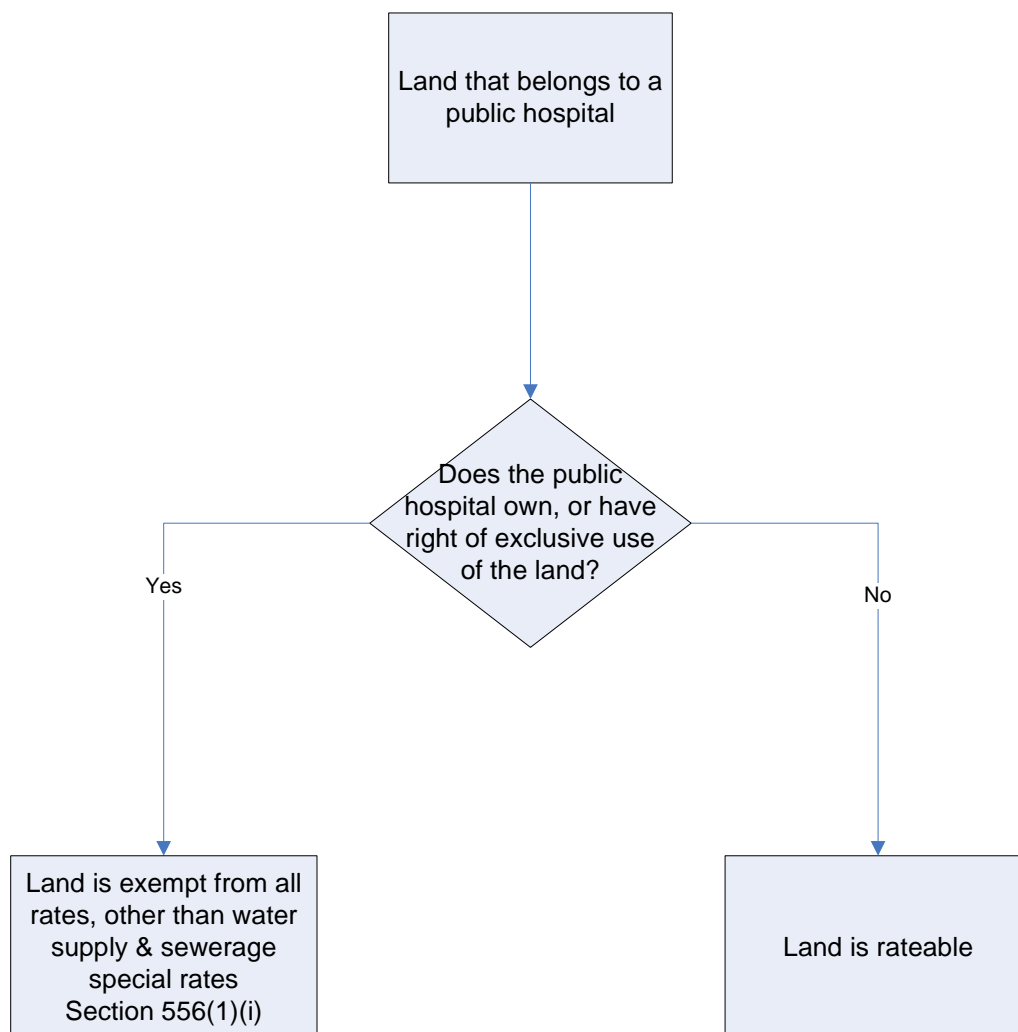

"Belongs to" is taken to mean to own, or have right of exclusive use of the land.

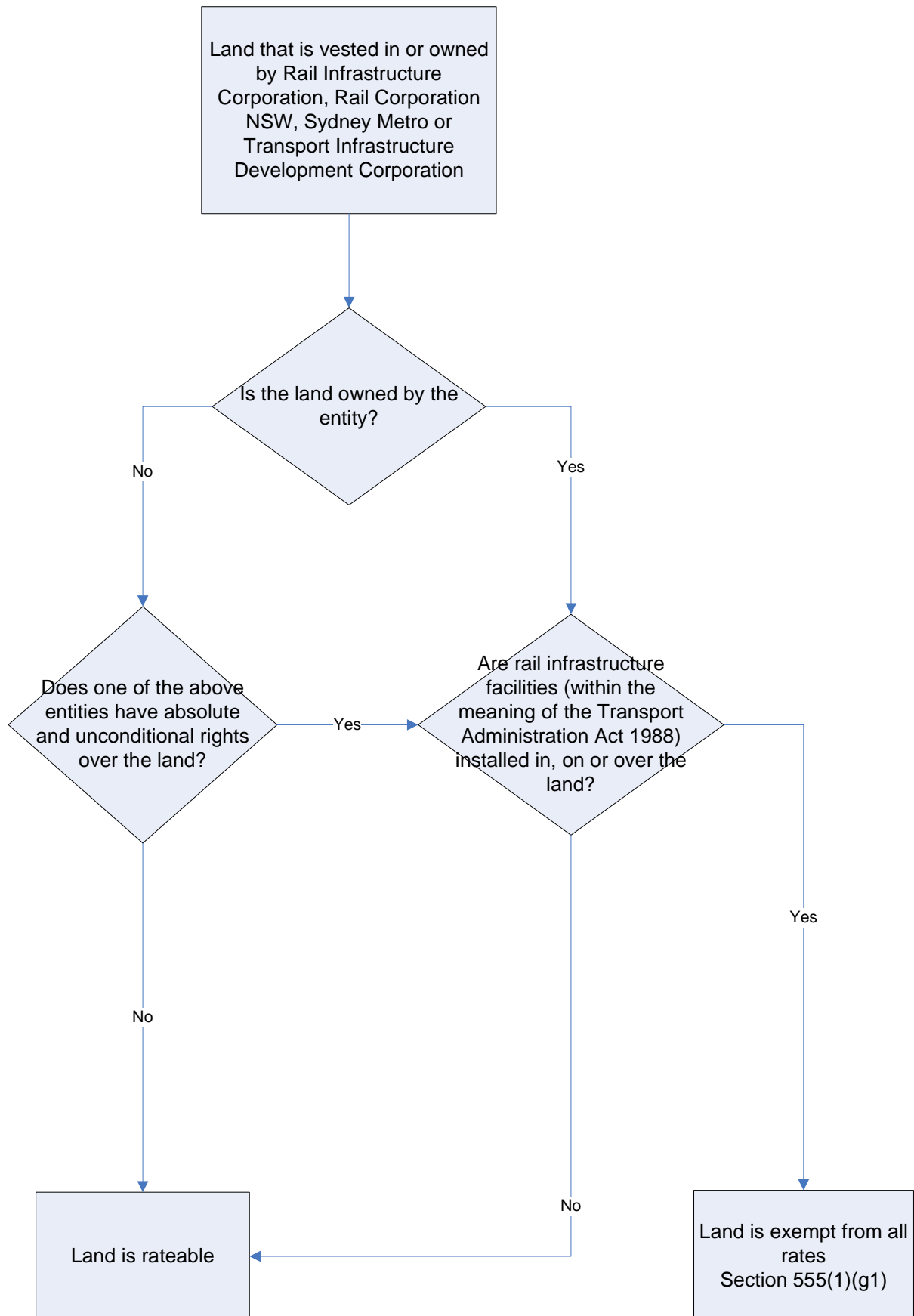
Land that belongs to a public hospital

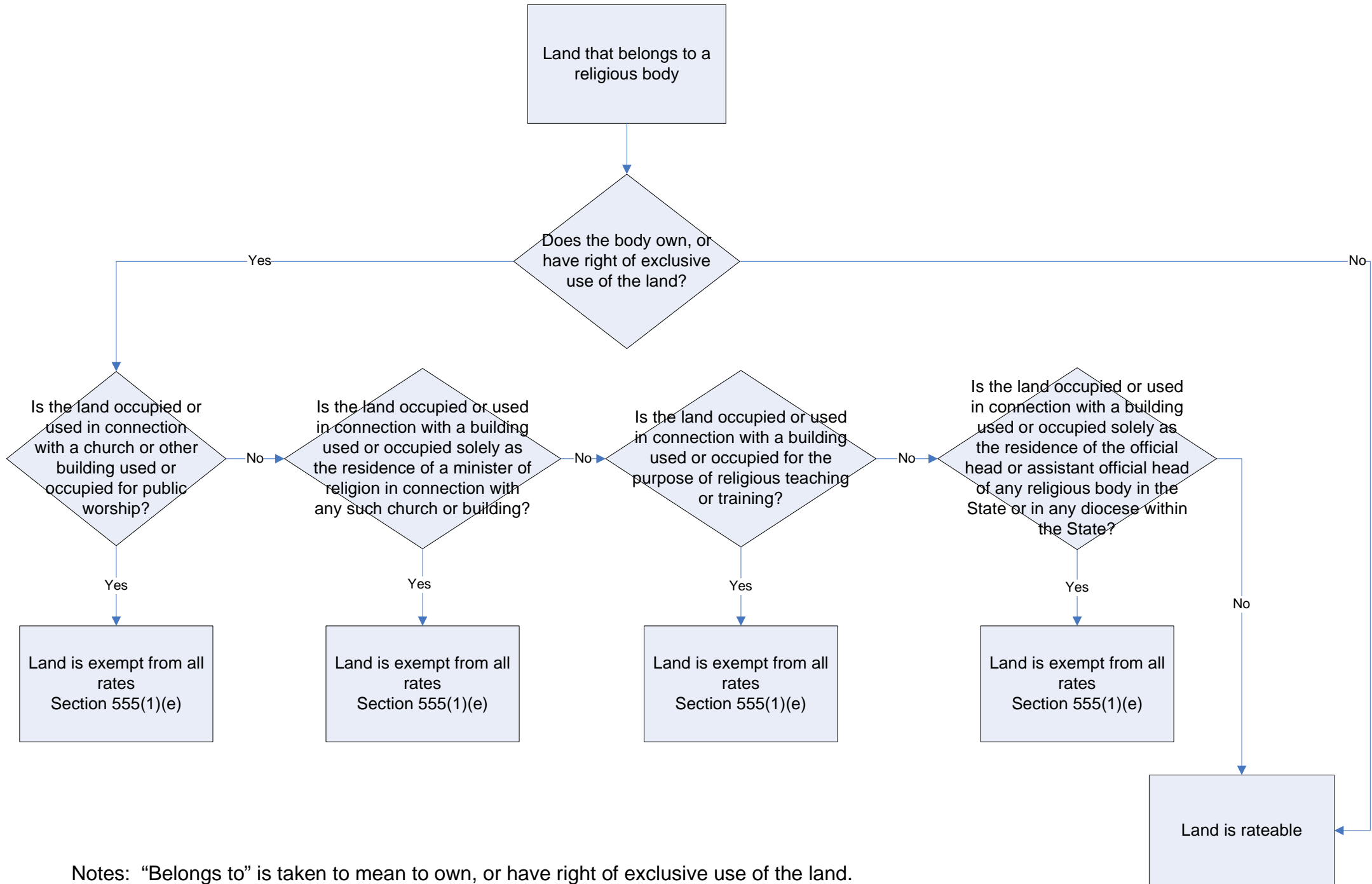
Land that is vested in or owned by Rail Infrastructure Corporation, Rail Corporation NSW, Sydney Metro or Transport Infrastructure Development Corporation

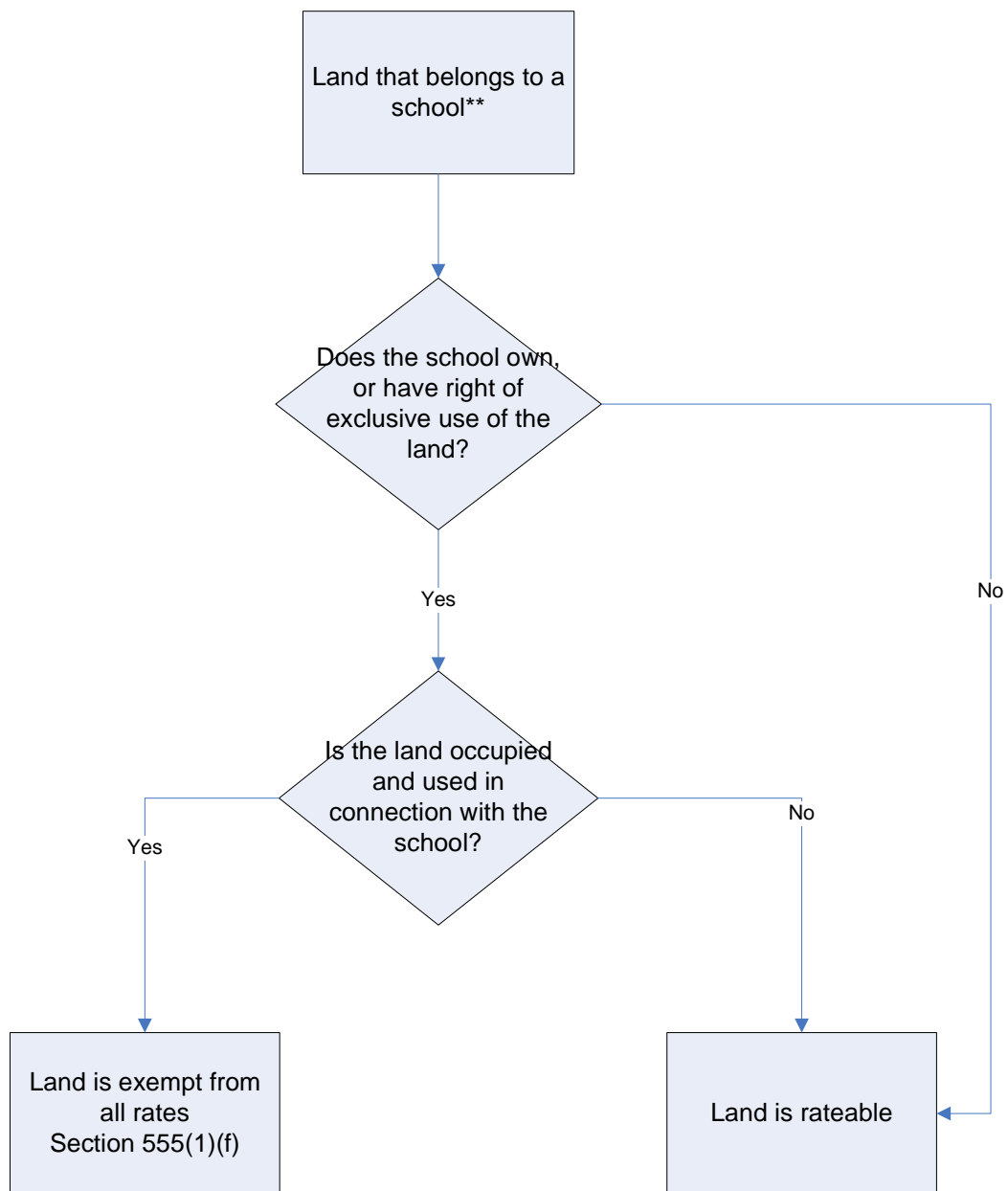
“Vested in” is taken to mean to have absolute and unconditional rights over the land.

Land that belongs to a school



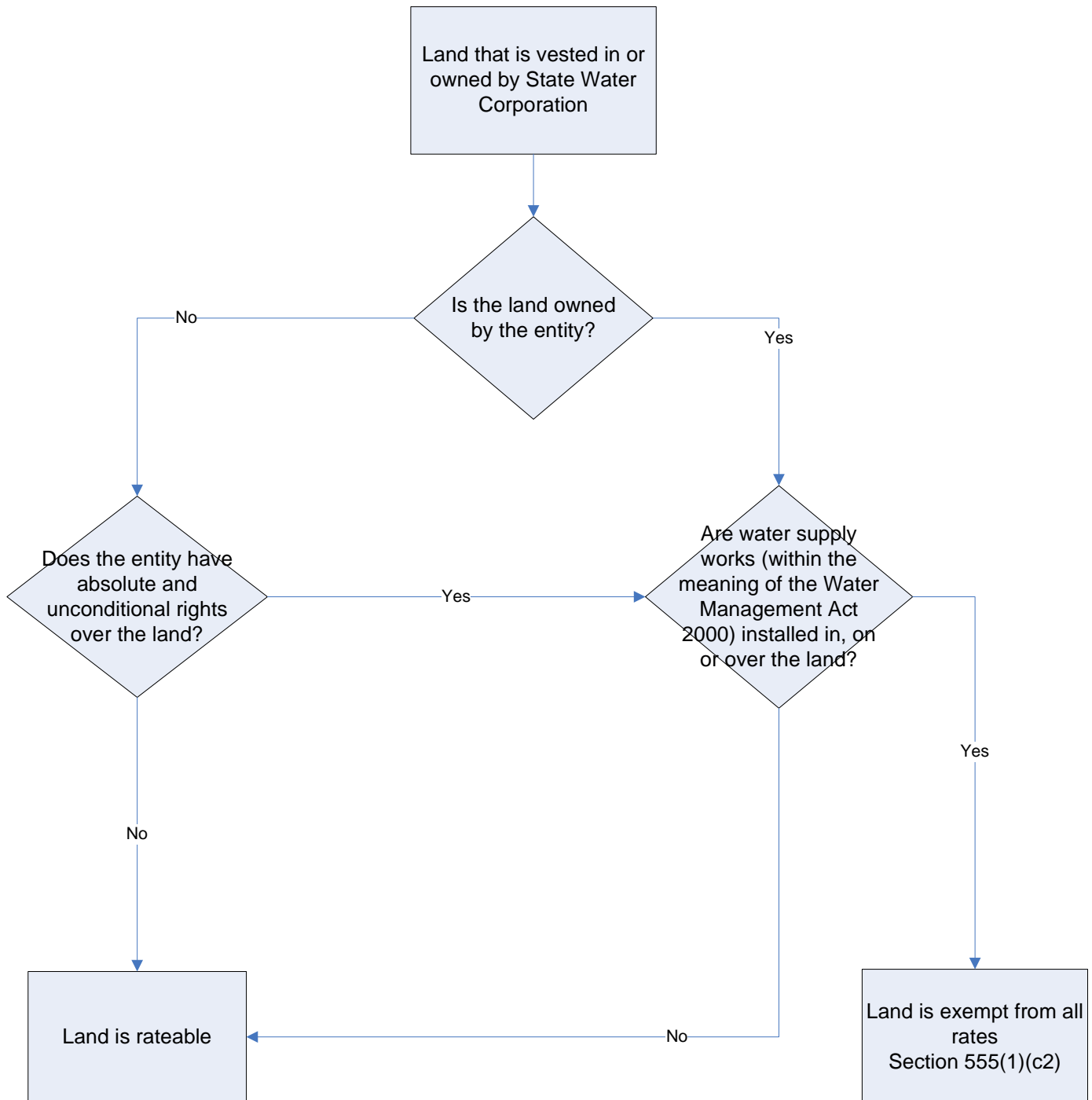
Notes:

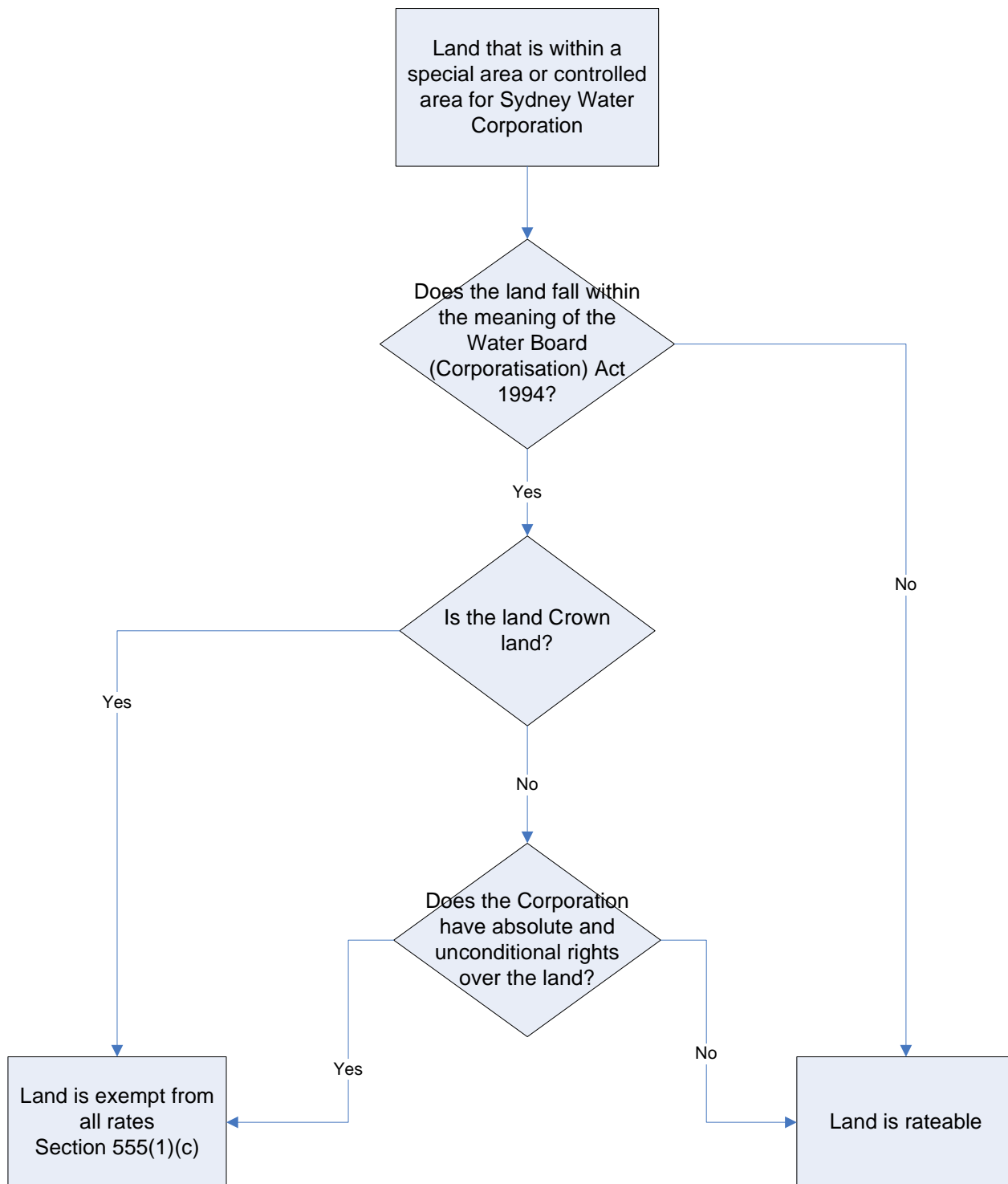
Land that is vested in or owned by State Water Corporation

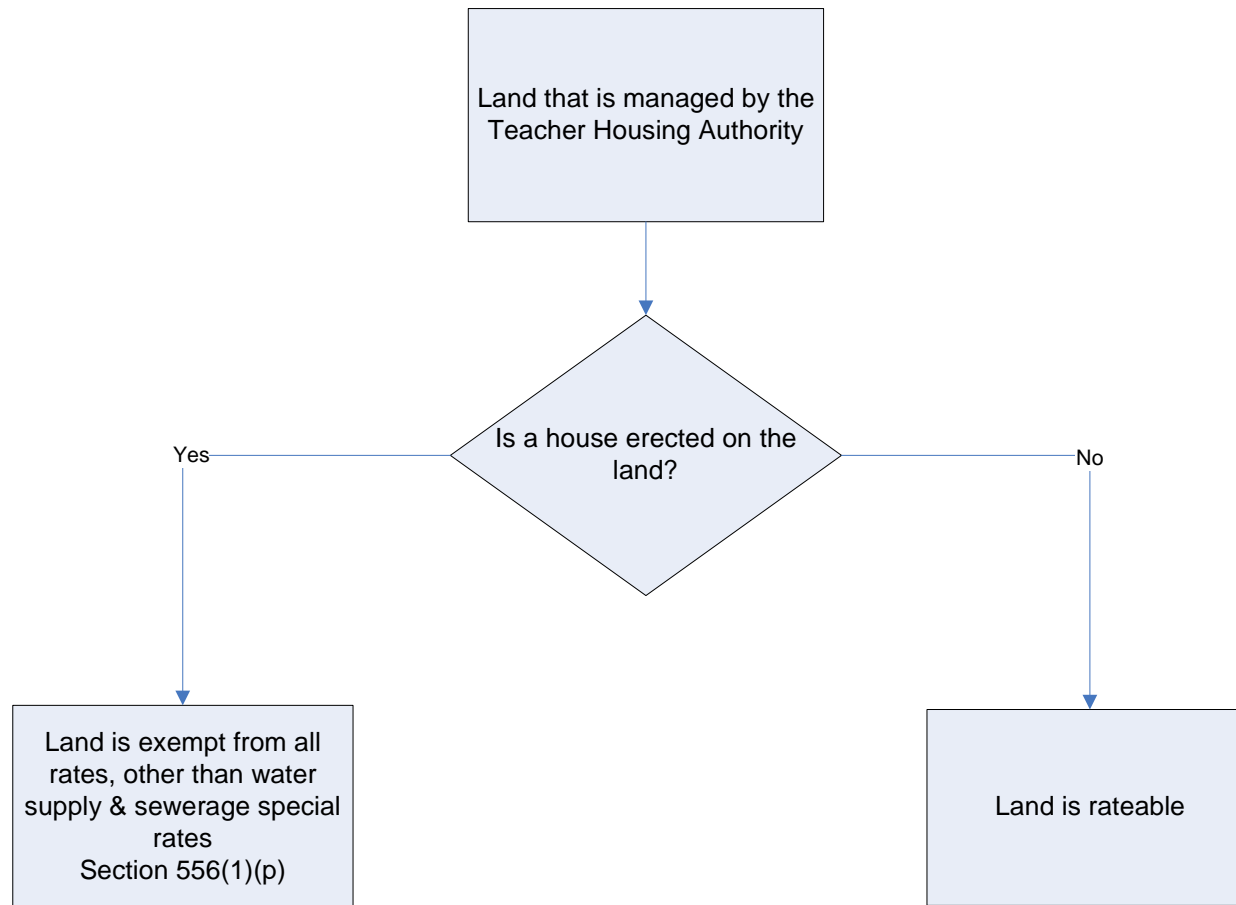
Land that is within a special area or controlled area for Sydney Water Corporation



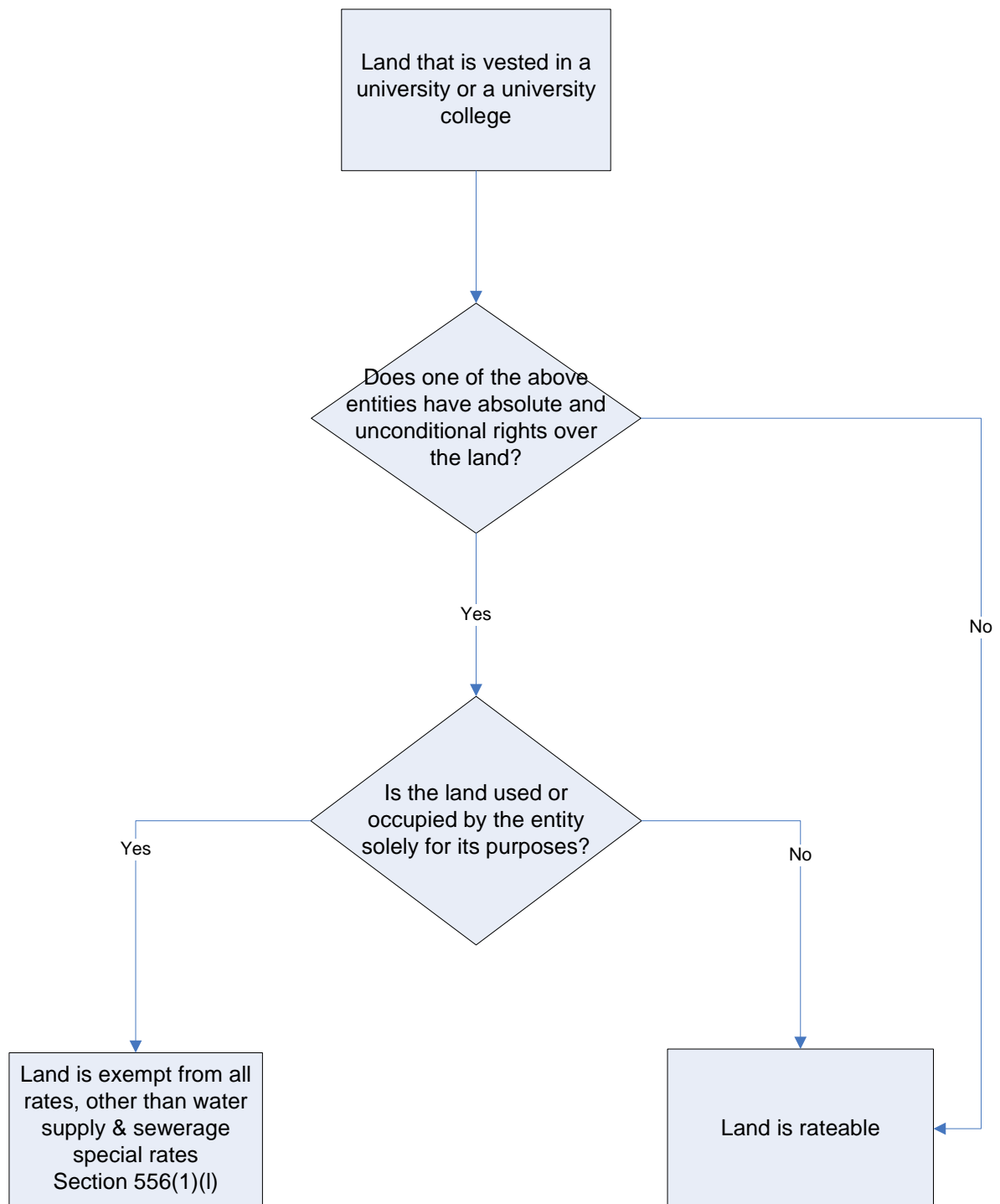

Land that is managed by the Teacher Housing Authority



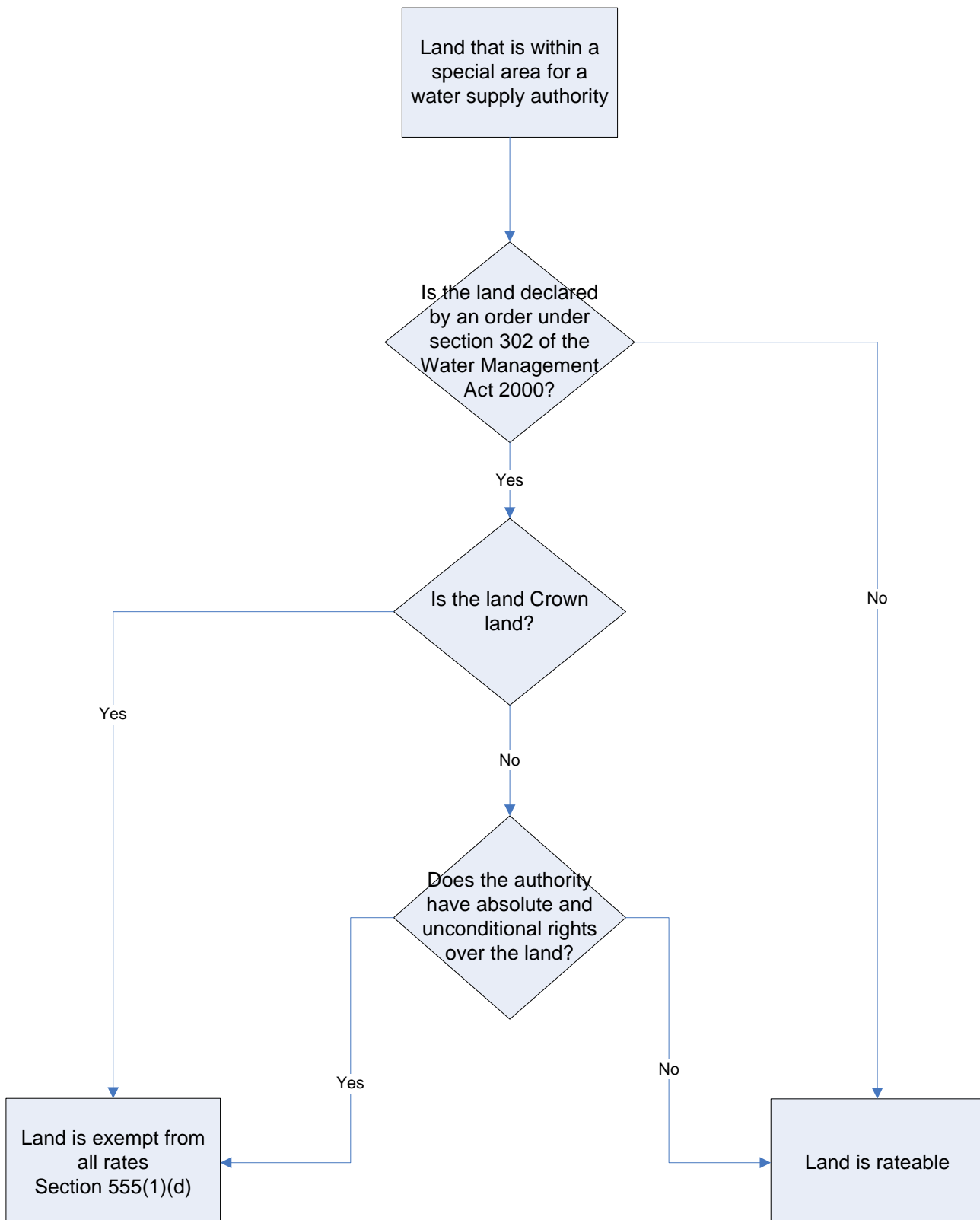
Land that is vested in a university, or a university college



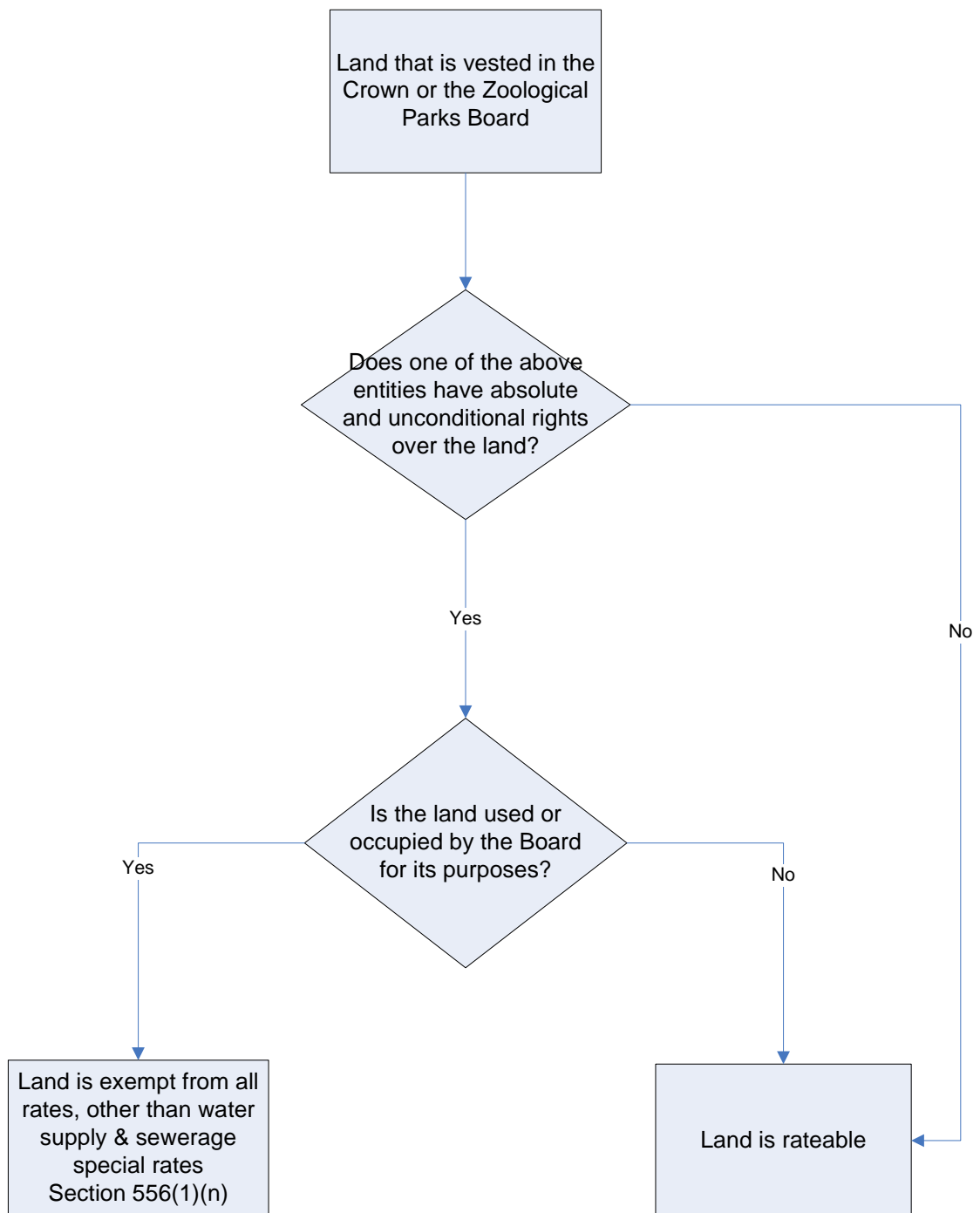
